- Review the basic operants Based on B.F. Skinner's book "Verbal Behavior" (1957) which proposes that language is a **behavior**. This behavior is influenced primarily through **reinforcement**, and on establishing and maintaining the **motivation** to learn.
- Discuss the importance of teaching the function of language. Teaching procedures focus on transferring the child's ability to respond across all functional categories. A "word" is not considered "learned" until it can be used across all functions.
- How to make your Intensive one-on-one therapy time a "language-learning environment".
- Provide hands-on training using specific teaching procedures at the table.
